



## Vienna - suggested activities

### 1. [Stephansdom \(St. Stephen`s Cathedral\)](#)

- Vienna`s landmark and Austria`s most eminent Gothic edifice. You can just step in or you can climb the 343 steps to the tower-keeper`s room and enjoy a breathtaking view over the city. Open daily.
- Where: Stephansplatz, U-Bahn station Stephansplatz (U1, U3), Price: Church – free, Tower – 4,5EUR

### 2. [Schloss Schönbrunn \(Schönbrunn Palace\)](#)

- Visit former imperial summer residence. In its complex which contains a marvelous park, the Palm House, the Gloriette and a zoo you can spend a whole day. Open daily.
- Where: U-Bahn station Schönbrunn (U4), tram station Hietzing (10, 58, 60), Price: Park – free, Palace complex – from 3 up to 25EUR, Zoo – 15,50EUR

### 3. [Hofburg](#)

- The imperial winter residence and former center of the Habsburg Monarchy. Today Hofburg serves as the official seat of the president, but also of the National Library, the Spanish Riding School and many museums (Sisi museum). Different opening hours.
- Where: U-Bahn station Herrengasse (U3), tram station Burgring (1, 2, D, J), Price: from 11 up to 25EUR

### 4. [Ringstraße \(Ring Road\)](#)

- Ringstraße is a circular road (5,3km long) surrounding the city center which is lined by a large number of opulent public and private buildings. The most notable are: State Opera, Parliament, Rathaus (City Hall), Hofburg, Kunsthistorisches Museum (Museum of Art History), Naturhistorisches Museum (Museum of Natural History), Burgtheater, and University of Vienna.
- You can walk through, take trams 1, 2 (2,10EUR) or go by the Vienna Ring Tram which takes around without having to change lines (daily from 10:00 to 15:30, Where: Schwedenplatz (U1, U4), price: 8EUR)

### 5. [Albertina](#)

- Albertina houses approximately 65 000 drawings and approximately one million old masters prints, as well as more modern graphic works, photographs and architectural drawings. In the permanent exhibition you may see works by Monet, Renoir, Cézanne, Picasso, Kirchner, Giacometti, Bacon. Open daily.

- Where: U-Bahn stations Karlsplatz (U1, U2, U4) and Stephansplatz (U1), Tram stations Oper (Opernring) (1, 2) and Wien Oper (Kärntner Ring) (2, 62, D), Price: tickets from 11,90EUR
- 6. [Prater](#)**
- Prater is both a large public park and a large amusement park where you find famous Vienna Ferris wheel (Wiener Reisenrad). In Summer open daily.
  - Where: U-Bahn station Praterstern (U2), Tram station Praterstern (5, 0), Price: Riesenrad – 9EUR
- 7. [MuseumsQuartier \(MQ\)](#)**
- With about 70 cultural facilities, the MQ Wien is one of the largest art and culture complexes in the world. Institutions: Leopold Museum, MUMOK (Museum of Modern Art), Kunsthalle Wien (non-collecting art center), Architekturzentrum Wien, Tanzquartier (dance center)... Different opening hours.
  - Where: U-Bahn stations MuseumsQuartier (U2) and Volkstheater (U2, U3), Tram station Volkstheater (49), Price: from 19EUR
- 8. [Karlskirche \(St. Charles`s Church\)](#)**
- The most outstanding baroque church in Vienna. Open daily.
  - U-Bahn station Karlsplatz (U2, U4), Price: Free, cupola – 8EUR
- 9. [Naschmarkt](#)**
- Vienna`s most popular market (1,5km long) where you can buy fresh fruit, vegetables, exotic herbs, cheese, baked goods etc. and where you can find many small restaurants and cozy bars. Every Saturday flea market takes place here. Open from Mo to Sa.
  - Where: U-Bahn station Kettenbrückengasse (U4), Free entrance
- 10. [Wiener Staatoper \(Vienna State Opera\)](#)**
- Vienna is a city of classical music and Wiener Staatoper is considered one of the most important opera houses in the world. You might get a standing ticket just for 3EUR. Open daily.
  - Where: U-Bahn station Karlsplatz (U1, U2, U4), Tram stations Oper

### **Tips and tricks**

- Visit Vienna`s tourist website which works in 13 different languages: <http://www.wien.info/en>
- Get a “combi ticket” – 3 or 4 attractions in one ticket, usually valid more than one day, e.g.: Sisi Ticket: 25,50EUR, The Vienna Hofburg: 11,50EUR, MQ Art Ticket: 24,50EUR
- Get the Vienna Card which offers you more than 210 discounts and free travel on Vienna`s public transport. Discounts at museums, sights, theaters, concerts but also in shops, cafés and restaurants. More information here: <http://www.wien.info/en/travel-info/vienna-card>
